**Las Condes, . . . . . 175ml £4.40 / 250ml £6 / Bottle £17**  
**Sauvignon Blanc, Cenral Valley, Chile**  
A fresh young wine with aromas of melon & pineapple & a refreshing citrus note.

**Bella Modella, . . 175ml £4.60 / 250ml £6.5 / Bottle £18**  
**Pinot Grigio, IGT Umbria, Italy**  
Everyone's favourite, Pinot Grigio! Light & easy to drink - what's not to like?

**Flying Solo, . . . . . 175ml £5 / 250ml £7 / Bottle £20**  
**Grenache Blanc Viognier, Pays d' Oc, France**  
Grenache Blanc, a charming but overlooked variety, offers really lovely green apple & acidic snap. Viognier brings scent & lushness.

**De Bortoli, The . . . . . 175ml £6 / 250ml £8 / Bottle £23**  
**Accomplice, Chardonnay, South Australia**  
Medium bodied with lively peach & nectarine flavours. A rich creamy finish, & integrated oak adds character & complexity to this very enjoyable Chardonnay.

**Fiano d' Abruzzo, . . . 175ml £6 / 250ml £8 / Bottle £23**  
**Farnese Abruzzo, Italy**  
Charming, modern, intense but green-apple fresh. Fennel & Blossom. Multi-award winning producer.

**Mirror Lake, Sauvignon Blanc, . . . . . Bottle £24**  
**Marlborough, New Zealand**  
Bright & Clear. Scent of grapefruit & zippy tangerine. A very charming, silky texture.

**Lagar de Bouza, Albariño Rias . . . . . Bottle £27**  
**Baixas, Portugal**  
Portugal's most exciting white variety. Fresh, crisp flavours of lemon, lime & peach.

**Sancerre Blanc Dom, Noel et . . . . . Bottle £32**  
**Jean-Luc Raimbault, France**  
A delicious, stylish & balanced Sancerre that has a beautiful perfume & fine, mineral nature. Quite a ripe & fruity style for Sancerre with a tropical fruit centre, along with pears & apple. Zesty but with ripe acidity, lovely minerality.

## Rosé

**Cotes du Luberon . . 175ml £5 / 250ml £7 / Bottle £20**  
**Rosé, Famille Perrin Rhone, France**  
Classic easy drinking Provençal pale pink. A perfume of rose petals & citrus fruit compliments the grapefruit aromas & fresh fruits on the palate.

**Wildwood, . . . . . 175ml £4.90 / 250ml £6.80 / Bottle £19**  
**White Zinfandel, California, USA**  
At last something sweet! Ripe juicy strawberries with a lingering fresh finish.

## Red

**Les Condes, . . . . . 175ml £4.40 / 250ml £6 / Bottle £17**  
**Merlot, Central Valley, Chile**  
Intense aromas of ripe plums & cherries. Well balanced with soft tannins & pleasant finish.

**Cotes du Ventoux . . 175ml £5 / 250ml £7 / Bottle £20**  
**Rouge, Perrin & Fils, Rhone France**  
This Grenache-based red has plenty of juicy raspberry fruit. Mont Ventoux's cool climate brings nice acidity & some lively green pepper.

**'The Opportunist' . . 175ml £6 / 250ml £8 / Bottle £23**  
**Shiraz, South Australia**  
An aromatic bouquet of ripe fruits, cherries & blackcurrants. Notes of freshly ground coffee, dark chocolate, peppermint, liquorice & subtle pepper. Thick & Smooth.

**Finca Besaya, . . . . 175ml £6.5 / 250ml £8.5 / Bottle £24**  
**Rioja Crianza, Spain**  
A Tempranillo variety aged in American oak for 15 months. A tasty well balanced wine with ripe fruit notes, an intense dark red colour with an elegant finish of toasted wood, vanilla & coffee.

**Zuccardi Serie A, . . . 175ml £7 / 250ml £9 / Bottle £26**  
**Malbec Mendoza, Argentina**  
Everyone is drinking Malbec & with good reason! A nose full of black & red fruit combined with spicy aromas.

**Negroamaro 'Terramare' IGT . . . . . Bottle £26**  
**Salento, Italy**  
Fresh bright & alive with a wonderful blend of red fruit & earthy, savoury spices.

**Lopez de Haro, Rioja Reserva, Rioja, . . Bottle £28**  
**Spain**  
A blend of Tempranillo, Graciano & Garnacha. Medium bodied with a beautiful, rounded, sensual bouquet.

**Chateau Pey La Tour, Bordeaux, . . . . . Bottle £30**  
**Medoc, France**  
Fresh aromas of wild strawberries & kirsch. Fine & elegant with persistent smooth fruit flavours.

## Champagne & Fizz

**Contarini, Prosecco, Brut, . . . . Glass £7 Bottle £23**  
**DOC Treviso**  
Delicious, easy to drink refreshing fizz with a little apple & pear on the nose & a good cleansing acidity.

**Solealto Bianco Spumante . . . Glass £6 / Bottle £19**  
**Extra Dry, Contarini**  
Prettily fruited, with some cherry, rhubarb & custard. Clean & fresh flavour. Dry but moreish.

**Pierre Bertrand Brut, Premier Cru . . . . Bottle £48**  
**NV**  
From the village of Cumieres in the Marn Vallley. Pinot-dominated like most wines from this village, its pale gold, wonderfully peachy, lush & explosively juicy.
